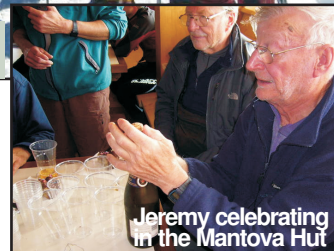
BIRTHDAY BOY!



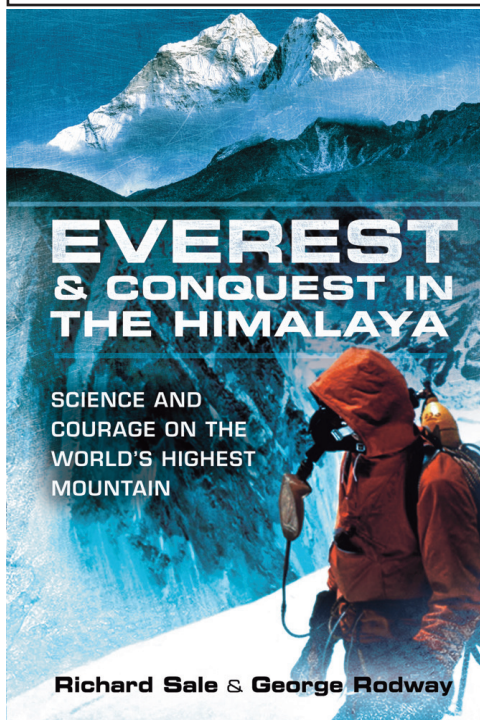
Jeremy (2nd L) and friends celebrate his 80th birthday on the Ludwigshöhe (4342m).

He has also written extensively on the history of high-altitude physiology for journals such as *High Altitude Medicine and Biology*.
